

NEEDLES

1 pair 4.00mm needles (USA 6) (UK 8)
1 4.00mm circular needle (USA 6) (UK 8)
4 stitch holders



BUTTONS

6 x 2.5cm buttons

TENSION

20 sts and 30 rows measured over 10cm (approx 4 in) of St st using 4.00mm needles.

POCKET LININGS

(Make 2).

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 23 sts. Work in St st until length measures 10cm, ending on a WS row. Place sts on a holder, and using a warm iron over a damp cloth, press flat.

LEFT FRONT

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 45(49,57,61) sts.

Row 1 (RS) K2, *P1, K3; rep from * to last 3 sts, P1, K2.

Row 2 (WS) P2, *K1, P3; rep from * to last 3 sts, K1, P2.

These 2 rows form K3, P1 rib patt. Rep these 2

rows until band measures 4cm, ending on a WS row and dec 1(0,3,2) sts evenly across last row worked [44(49,54,59) sts].

Now working in St st throughout, work until length (from beg) measures 35cm, ending on a WS row.**

Insert pocket lining (RS) K11(14,17,20) sts, then leaving rem sts on the needle, work across top of pocket lining from st holder. Place next 23 sts of front piece onto a holder (pocket opening).

Work across rem 10(12,14,16) front sts. Cont working straight in St st until length (from beg) measures 70cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape armhole (RS) Cast off 3(4,5,6) sts at beg of row [41(45,49,53) sts].

(WS) Work 1 row.

(RS) (dec) K2, sl1, K1, pssso, K to end.

This row sets patt for dec.

Dec 1 st as set on foll alt rows 5(6,7,8) times [35(38,41,44) sts, 13(15,17,19) shaping rows].

Work 26 rows straight.

Shape neck (WS) Cast off 8(9,10,11) sts at beg of row [27(29,31,33) sts].

(RS) (dec) K to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2.

This row sets patt for dec.

Dec 1 st as set on foll alt rows 8 times [18(20,22,24) sts, 18 neck shaping rows].

Work 7 rows straight.

Shape shoulder (RS) Cast off 6(7,7,8) sts at beg this and foll alt row.

(WS) Work 1 row [4 shoulder shaping rows].

(RS) Cast off rem 6(6,8,8) sts.

RIGHT FRONT

Work as for left front to **.

Insert pocket lining (RS) K10(12,14,16) sts, then leaving rem sts on the needle, work across top of pocket lining from st holder. Place next 23 sts of front piece onto a holder (pocket opening).

Work across rem 11(14,17,20) front sts. Cont working straight in St st until length (from beg) measures 70cm, ending on a WS row.

(RS) Work 1 row.

Shape armhole (WS) Cast off 3(4,5,6) sts at beg of row [41(45,49,53) sts].

(RS) Work 1 row.

(WS) (dec) P2, P2tog, P to end.

This row sets patt for dec. Dec 1 st as set on foll alt rows 5(6,7,8) times [35(38,41,44) sts, 13(15,17,19) shaping rows].

Work 26 rows straight.

Shape neck (RS) Cast off 8(9,10,11) sts at beg of row [27(29,31,33) sts].

(WS) (dec) P to last 4 sts, P2tog tbl, P2.

This row sets patt for dec.

Dec 1 st as set on foll alt rows 8 times [18(20,22,24) sts, 18 neck shaping rows].

Work 7 rows straight.

Shape shoulder (WS) Cast off 6(7,7,8) sts at beg this and foll alt row.

(RS) Work 1 row [4 shoulder shaping rows].

(WS) Cast off rem 6(6,8,8) sts.

BACK

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 89(101,109,121) sts.

Row 1 (RS) K2, *P1, K3; rep from * to last 3 sts, P1, K2.

Row 2 (WS) P2, *K1, P3; rep from * to last 3 sts, K1, P2.

These 2 rows form K3, P1 rib patt.

Rep these 2 rows until band measures 4cm, ending on a WS row, and dec 1(3,1,3) sts evenly across last row worked [88(98,108,118) sts].

Now working in St st throughout, work straight until length (from beg) measures 70cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape armholes (RS) Cast off 3(4,5,6) sts at beg of next 2 rows [82(90,98,106) sts].

(RS) (dec) K2, sl1, K1, pssso, K to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2.

This row sets patt for dec.

Dec 2 sts as set on foll alt rows 5(6,7,8) times [70(76,82,88) sts, 13(15,17,19) shaping rows].

Work 51 rows straight.

Shape shoulders (RS) Cast off 6(7,7,8) sts at beg next 4 rows [46(48,54,56) sts].

(RS) Cast off 6(6,8,8) sts at beg next 2 rows.

Cast off rem 34(36,38,40) sts.

SLEEVES

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 49(53,57,61) sts.

Row 1 (RS) K2, *P1, K3; rep from * to last 3 sts, P1, K2.

Row 2 (WS) P2, *K1, P3; rep from * to last 3 sts, K1, P2.

These 2 rows form K3, P1 rib patt.

Rep these 2 rows until band measures 4cm, ending on a WS row and dec 1 st on last row worked [48(52,56,60) sts].

Now working in St st throughout, work 12(10,3,0) rows straight.

Shape sleeve (RS) (inc) Inc 1 st at each end of this row, then foll 12th(10th,9th,8th) rows, 9(11,13,15) times [68(76,84,92) sts, 121 rows from band].

Cont working straight until length (from beg) measures 48cm, ending on a WS row.

Shape sleeve cap (RS) Cast off 3(4,5,6) sts at beg of next 2 rows.

(RS) (dec) K2, sl1, K1 pssso, K to last 4 sts, K2tog, K2.

This row sets patt for dec.

Dec 2 sts as set on of foll 4th rows, 4(5,6,7) times, then foll alt rows 12(10,8,6) times, then every row 7(9,11,13) times [14(18,22,26) sts, 50(52,54,56) sleeve cap shaping rows]. Cast off rem sts.

MAKING UP

Press all pieces gently, on WS using a warm iron over a damp cloth. With RS tog, using backstitch, join shoulder seams.

With RS tog, centre sleeves to shoulder

seam and using backstitch, join to bodice. Using edge to edge st, join side and sleeve seams. Press seams gently.

Buttonhole band Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 11 sts.

Row 1 (RS) K1, *P1, K1; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) P1, *K1, P1; rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form K1, P1 rib.

Rep these 2 rows once [4 rows].

Make buttonhole (RS) K1, P1, K1, P1, cast off 3 sts, P1, K1, P1, K1.

(WS) P1, K1, P1, K1, cast on 3 sts, K1, P1, K1, P1.

Cont in rib patt for 34 rows.

Rep last 36 rows 4 times, then 2 buttonhole rows again [186 rows, 6 buttonholes].

Now cont in rib patt until length measures the same as front edge.

Leave sts on a holder.

Button band Make as per buttonhole band, omitting buttonholes.

Leave sts on a holder

Using edge to edge st, join buttonhole band to right front edge, and button band to left front edge. Press seams gently.

Collar Using 4.00mm needles, pickup 11 sts from holder across right front band, 30(31,32,33) sts up right side front neck, 29(31,33,35) sts across back neck, 30(31,32,33) sts down left side front neck, 11 sts from holder across left front band [111(115,119,123) sts].

Row 1 (WS of garment, RS of collar) *K3, P1; rep from * to last 3 sts, K3.

Row 2 (RS of garment, WS of collar) *P3, K1; rep from * to last 3 sts, P3.

These 2 rows form K3, P1 rib patt.

Rep these 2 rows until collar measures 12cm, ending on a WS row.

Cast off loosely in rib.

Attach pocket lining Pin edges of lining to bodice, then stitch into place using slip stitch, being sure that the stitching isn't visible on the front.

Pocket tops Work across 23 sts on holder at pocket openings as follows;

Row 1 (RS) K3, *P1, K3; rep from * to end.

Row 2 (WS) P3, *K1, P3; rep from * to end.

These 2 rows form K3, P1 rib patt.

Rep these 2 rows until rib measures 4cm.

Cast off loosely in rib. Using a warm iron over a damp cloth, press rib to width of pocket, without flattening.

Using slip stitch, join edges of pocket top to bodice.

Sew on buttons to correspond to buttonholes.
