

NEEDLES

1 pair 4.00mm needles (USA 6) (UK 8) 1 pair 3.75mm needles (USA 5) (UK 9) 1 3.75mm circular needle 60cm long (USA 5) (UK 9)

2 stitch holders



51.5(56.5,62.5,67.5)cm

TENSION

20 sts and 30 rows measured over 10cm (approx 4 in) of St st using 4.00mm needles.

POCKET LININGS

(Make 2).

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 25 sts. Work 49 rows in St st. Break off yarn and leave sts on holder.

FRONT

Using 3.75mm needles, cast on 103(113,125,135) sts.

(WS) Work in Garter st (knit all rows) until work measures 24cm from beg, ending on a WS row. **

Insert Pocket Linings

Change to 4.00mm needles, K14(16,17,19), then K across RS of first pocket lining. Then using a separate pair of 3.75mm needles and another ball of yarn, K next 25 sts of front, turn work to WS, then cast off these 25 sts loosely knitwise for pocket top and fasten off. Turn work to RS, using 4.00mm needles and



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cont from pocket lining, K across next 25(31,41,47) sts of front, then K across RS of second pocket lining.

Then using a separate pair of 3.75mm needles and another ball of yarn, K across next 25 sts of Front, turn work to WS, then cast off these 25 sts loosely knitwise for pocket top and fasten off.

Turn work to RS, using 4.00mm needles and cont from pocket lining, K across rem 14(16,17,19) sts of front [103(113,125,135) sts].

(WS) K14(16,17,19), P25, K25(31,41,47), P25, K14(16,17,19).

(RS) Now working in St st for rem, work until length measures 46cm from beg, ending on a WS row.

Shape left v- neck (RS) K51(56,62,67), turn, leave rem sts on a holder.

Work each side of neck separately.

(WS) Work 1 row.

(RS) Dec 1 st at end (neck edge) of this row, then foll 4th row [49(54,60,65) sts]. Work 3 rows straight.

Shape left armhole (RS) Cast off 10(11,13,14) sts, K to last 2 sts, K2tog [38(42,46,50) sts].

Cont dec 1 st at end (neck edge) of foll 4th rows, 2(3,4,6) times [36(39,42,44) sts], then on foll 6th rows, 9(9,9,8) times [27(30,33,36) sts].

Work 3 rows straight.

Shape left shoulder (RS) Cast off 9(10,11,12) sts at beg of next row, then on foll alt row. Work 1 row.

Cast off rem 9(10,11,12) sts.

With RS facing, rejoin yarn to rem sts, K2tog, then knit to end [51(56,62,67) sts].

(WS) Work 1 row.

(RS) Dec 1 st at beg (neck edge) of this row, then foll 4th rows, twice

[48(53,59,64) sts]. **Shape armhole (WS)** Cast off 10(11,13,14) sts, P to end [38(42,46,50) sts]. Cont dec 1 st at beg (neck edge) of foll 3rd row, then foll 4th rows, 1(2,3,5) time/s [24(39,42,44) stc] then on foll 6th rows

[36(39,42,44) sts], then on foll 6th rows, 9(9,9,8) times [27(30,33,36) sts]. Work 4 rows straight.

Shape shoulder (WS) Cast off 9(10,11,12) sts at beg of this row, then foll alt row.

Work 1 row. Cast off rem 9(10,11,12) sts.

BACK

Work as for Front to **.

Knit 2 rows.

(RS) Change to 4.00mm needles and working in St st, work until back measures 46cm from beg, ending on a WS row. Work 10 rows straight.

Shape armholes (RS) Cast off 10(11,13,14) sts at beg of next 2 rows [83(91,99,107) sts]. Work 64(68,72,74) rows St st, ending on a WS row.

Shape shoulders (RS) Cast off 9(10,11,12) sts at beg of next 6 rows [29(31,33,35) sts]. Leave rem sts on holder.

SLEEVES

Using 3.75mm needles, cast on 53(57,61,65) sts.

(RS) Work 6 rows Garter st (knit all rows). **Shape cuff (RS)** Cont in Garter st, dec 1 st at each end of this row, then foll 8th rows, twice [47(51,55,59) sts].

Cont in Garter st, work 10 rows straight. **(RS)** Change to 4.00mm needles and working in St st throughout, work 10 rows straight.

Shape sleeve (RS) (inc) K2, M1, K to last 2 sts, M1, K2.

This row sets patt for inc. Inc 1 st as set at each end of every foll 6th row, 19 times [87(91,95,99) sts].

Work straight until length measures 44cm from end of cuff, ending on a WS row. Tie a marker at each end of last row to indicate end of sleeve seam

Work another 16(18,20,22) rows straight. **Shape top** Cast off 8(8,9,9) sts at beg of next 8 rows [23(27,23,27) sts]. Cast off rem sts loosely.

MAKING UP

Press all pieces gently, except garter st sections, on WS using a warm iron over a damp cloth. With RS tog, using backstitch, join shoulder seams.

Neckband With RS facing, using 3.75mm circular needle and beg at left shoulder seam, pick up 48(50,52,54) sts evenly along left side of front neck (last of these sts is first centre st), pick up and K 48(50,52,54) sts evenly along right side of front neck (first of these sts is second centre st), then K across sts on back holder - dec 1 st at each end of holder [123(129,135,141) sts]. Round 1 K to within 1 st of 2 centre sts, sl1,

K1, psso, K2tog, K to end.


Rep this round 3 times.

Cast off loosely knitwise.

Using backstitch, sew sleeve in position with centre to shoulder seam and extra 16(18,20,22) rows worked at top of sleeve placed along sts cast off at armholes on back and front.

Join sleeve and side seams, rev seam for Garter st section on sleeve cuff. Fold back cuffs and secure in position. Slip stitch pocket linings in position to WS of

Front and secure edges of pocket tops in position. Press seams.



Chequer Scarf

An easy scarf worked in a simple knit and purl chequer pattern

YARN

Colour

Quantity

Jo Sharp Silkroad DK Tweed x 50g balls 407 Magnolia 4

MEASUREMENTS

Measurements given in inches are approximate. Width - 20.5cm (8 in). Length - 178cm (70 in).

178cm

NEEDLES

1 pair 4.00mm needles (USA 6) (UK 8)

TENSION

22 sts and 27 rows measured over 10cm (approx 4 in) of Chequer Pattern using 4.00mm needles.



SCARF

20.5cm

Using 4.00mm needles, cast on 45 sts. **Row 1 (RS)** (K5, P5) 4 times, K5. **(WS)** (P5, K5) 4 times, P5. **Rep these 2 rows twice [6 rows]. (RS)** (P5, K5) 4 times, P5. **(WS)** (K5, P5) 4 times, K5. Rep these 2 rows twice [12 rows]. These 12 rows form Chequer patt rep. Cont working in Chequer patt until length measures approx 178cm, ending on last row of patt rep. Cast off.
